Dickson Validated and Calibrated Data Loggers combined with DicksonWare™ Secure software will electronically record temperature and humidity conditions. This system follows 21 CFR Part 11 regulations and provides password protection, encrypted data, electronic signature and audit trail capability.

This Guide is designed to get you started with DicksonWare™ Secure software right away. It shows you how to install the program and points you to important information on your program and logger.

Installing the Software

To install DicksonWare™ Secure on your PC:

- DicksonWare™ Secure software requires a computer running Windows 98 or later and a dedicated serial or USB port.
- Start Windows if Windows is not already running.
- Insert the DicksonWare™ Secure software CD in your drive.

- If it doesn't Auto-Start, click Start, then choose Run.
- If you insert the CD in drive D, type **d:\setup** and press **Enter**.
- Follow the instructions presented by the DicksonWare™ setup program. The default directory is **c:\dickson\dwSecure**, but you can change this if you want.

Starting the Software

To start the DicksonWare™ Secure program, double click the DicksonWare™ Secure icon on your desktop (or Select Start, Programs, Dickson, then select the appropriate program item). The initial administrator

password is DICKSON. We recommend that you immediately change the password by clicking on Security and Change Password from the menu bar.

Network Quick Start

- After DicksonWare™ Secure is opened, connect the logger to the computer with a USB or serial port.
- Get a valid IP address from your network administrator.
- Click on the "Setup" button under the Network tab and enter in the data logger's new IP address.

- You may now disconnect the logger from your computer and connect it to your companies network. Once it is connected to the Network, use "Scan All" button to initially locate your networked logger.

Using Help

Help files are the primary source of information about Dickson Loggers and DicksonWare™ Secure software. Please read the information contained in the Help files carefully to get the most out of your new logger

and software. You can view the Help files from within DicksonWare™ Secure by pressing F1 or by selecting Help from the menu bar.
