CHALLENGE

- ⌘ To look for an alternative digital signage application to replace the MagicNet software which is supplied on previously installed Samsung SM400DXn's in order to use the screens to the best of their ability.
- ⌘ Need to show a mixture of media including custom RSS, stored video and streaming video being distributed by the new IP streaming system.
- ⌘ Requirement to tailor messages to specific screens for staff, parents and students.
- ⌘ To display information and entertainment so students can have informative yet relaxing breaks.

SOLUTION

- ⌘ Implemented 7 x signagelive enabled Samsung SM400DXn commercial LCD with integrated PC's supplied with 3 years hotswap maintenance and utilised an existing PC connected to Sanyo's 42" outdoor LCD display.
- ⌘ Applicable public RSS feeds were added to a playlist to provide real-time information.

RESULTS

- ⌘ All Saints School are now using the Samsung DXn's with greater flexibility to meet the requirements of staff, parents and students.
- ⌘ The conversion from MagicNet to signagelive is made easy by simply running the signagelive Samsung upgrade installer.
